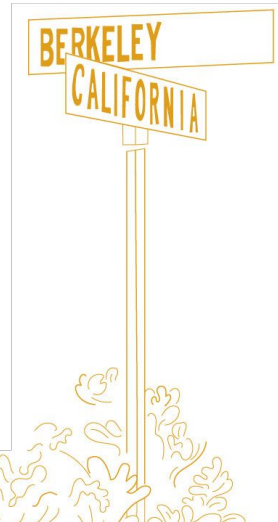
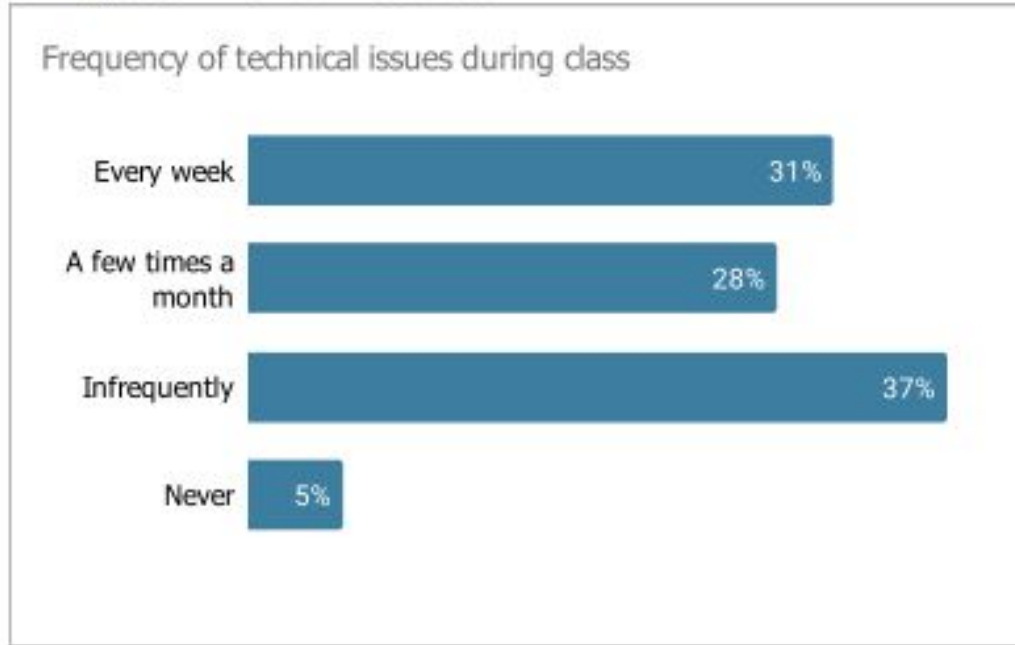
How is remote instruction going?

How are instructors, advisors, and department staff doing with remote delivery of services?



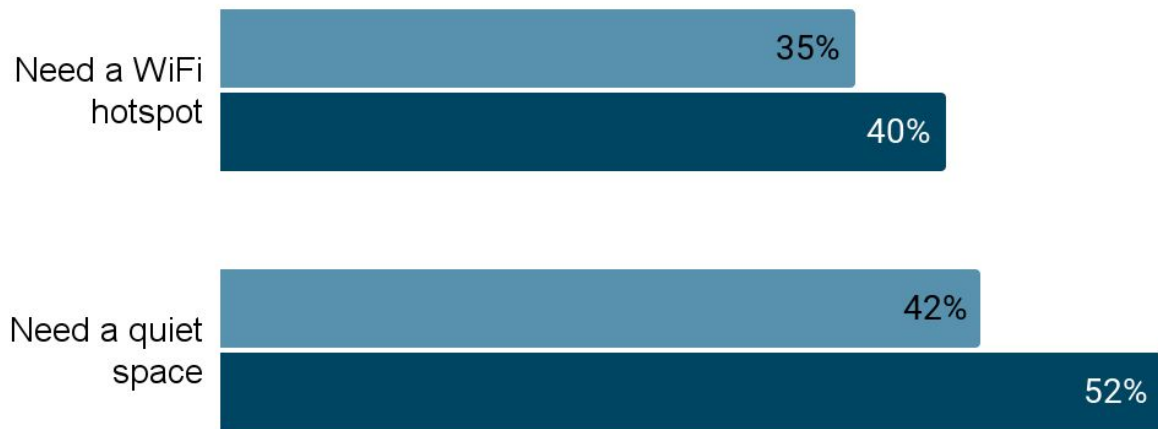
“How often has an instructor had technical problems or issues during your class?”

Range 23% to 43%

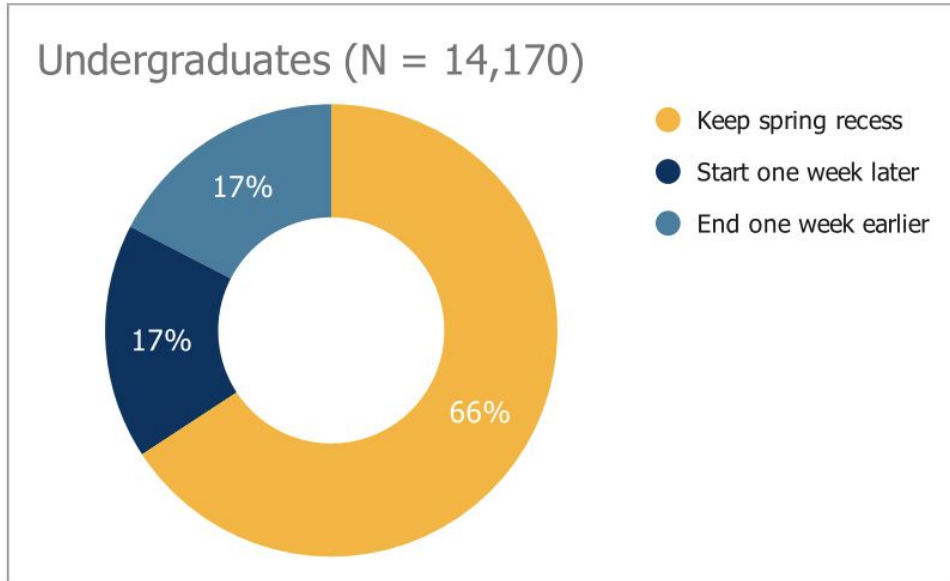
What issue pushed 47% of undergraduates to respond to the pulse survey?

Academic Calendar for Spring 2021

Two-thirds of undergraduates and over half of graduate students would prefer to keep spring recess and leave the Spring 2021 academic calendar unchanged.

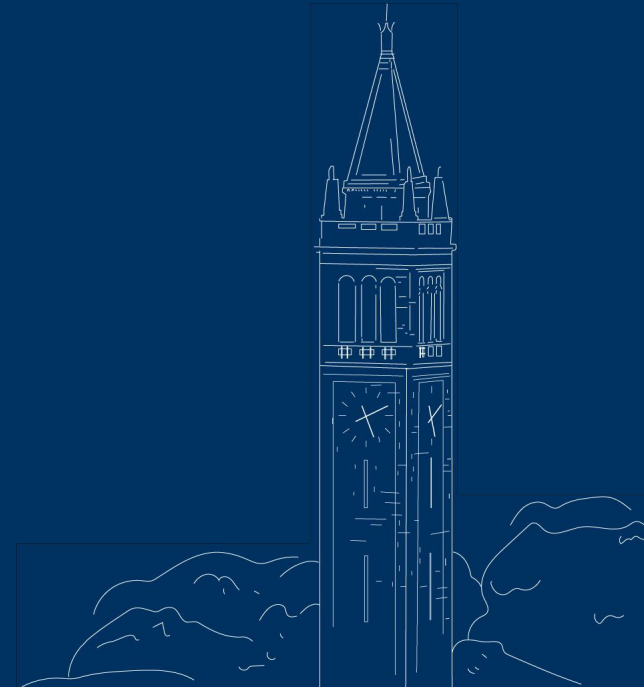

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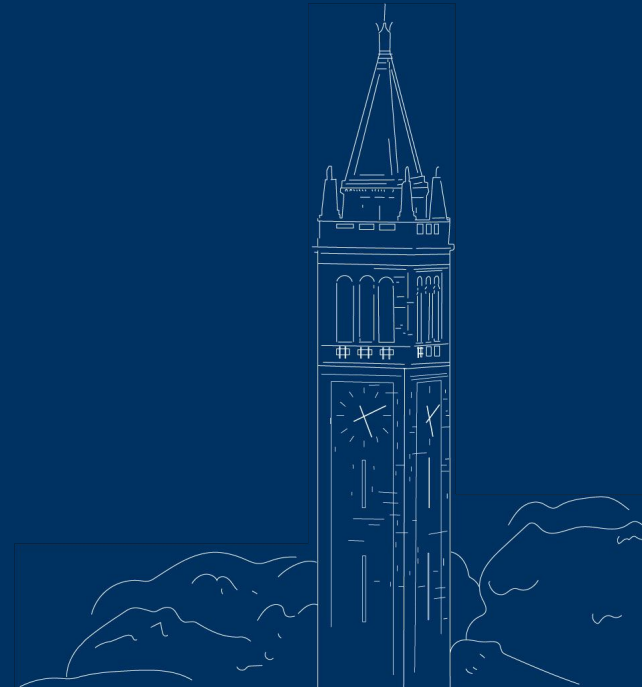

Campus Response

Second student pulse survey now open

With the ongoing changes due to the pandemic, we want to check in every few weeks to hear about student experiences and needs via one-minute surveys. [Pulse Survey #2](#) is currently open to all undergraduate and graduate students. The [report from Pulse Survey #1](#) is now available and below are some findings:

- Many students said they need more [Technology Equity Program](#) laptops and 1,200 noise-canceling headphones.
- Over 50% of undergraduates attend a class at least a few times a month. We encourage you to update their [Keep Teaching](#) survey for faculty support. They need [instructors](#) to get quick support from faculty in creating more consistent class schedules.
- Students said they would use more consultations with a University Career Center. Remember that UC Berkeley has [resources](#) through the Tang Center.

Latest student pulse survey now open

The spring 2021 [Student Pulse Survey #2](#) is open to all students until March 9. Share your perceptions of academic dishonesty and your experiences with student support services during the pandemic. The [report from Pulse Survey #1](#) is now available and below are some findings:

- Compared to fall 2020, students are still requesting recordings of classes and needing private, quiet space. Need a private space? [Book an individual workroom](#) at the ASUC Student Union.
- Zoom burnout is being felt more than half the days or nearly every day by 57% of undergraduates and 45% of graduate students. Beat pandemic fatigue and [find your fun](#).
- Some students still need equipment for remote learning. The [Student Technology Equity Program](#) continues to offer free loaner laptops, Wi-Fi hotspots, and other peripherals (e.g. webcam, headphones, etc.) for students in need.

– Pulse Survey #1 - Special Topic: Instruction & Resources –

Administered between the 3rd and 5th weeks of classes, 10,760 (34%) undergraduates and 4,484 (38%) graduate students completed the first survey. Congratulations to our first prize winners of the random drawing for Apple AirPods: Sarah Jarrett (graduate student, Landscape Architecture), Ray Altenberg (undergraduate, Computer Science) and Amr Eissa (undergraduate, L&S).
